Declaration of commitment of Università degli Studi di Roma La Sapienza to the Charter for European Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the recruitment of researchers (2005/251/EC)

Università degli Studi di Roma La Sapienza, represented by its Rector, prof. Eugenio Gaudio, is strongly intentioned to comply with the principles the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the recruitment of researchers.

Through the decision made by the Academic Senate on 19 July 2016, in particular Sapienza undertakes to:

- implement the principles and values declared in the Charter and Code of Conduct:
- promote the enhancement and development of human resources throughout the whole career and acknowledge the value of geographic, interdisciplinary and intersectoral (public-private) mobility as a way of strengthening scientific knowledge and achieving the researchers' professional development;
- guarantee fair and attractive conditions, in terms of grants and salaries;
- request researchers to pursue the objectives enshrined in the Charter, by implementing them in their profession;
- urge the regional and national institutions to adopt policies and measures compatible with the guidelines defined by the Charter and the Code of Conduct.
